IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. Joel and Emily Archbald will remove the elm and three stumps on the boundary fence by 28 November 2014;
- 2. Tracey Templeton will allow Joel and Emily Archbald reasonable access to perform the work;
- 3. All work done from Tracey Templeton's property to remove the trees will be limited to grinding only;
- 4. All work must be performed by an AQF Level 3 arborist (with appropriate insurance cover);

- 5. The costs of performing the work are to be borne by Joel and Emily Archbald;
- 6. Joel and Emily Archbald will refund to Tracey Templeton the sum of \$647.50 as her contribution towards the dividing fence;
- 7. The Application is withdrawn;
- 8. Each party pays its own legal costs; and
- 9. These orders are in full and final satisfaction of the issues in dispute.
