IT IS A DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT, BY CONSENT:

- 1. The registered owner of the lot at 4 Holmes Street, TOOWONG QLD 4066 ("the Tree-Keeper") arrange to have the following works carried out on the tree the subject of the dispute ("the Initial Works"):
 - (a) The Jacaranda tree to be pruned in line with the boundary fence so that the core is sustained and the tree is balanced.
 - (b) Dead wooding required in the lower crown and the exposed stub ends to be collar pruned. Limbs identified in Attachment A.
- 2. The Tree-Keeper arrange to have a follow up inspection on the Jacaranda tree the subject of the dispute on October 2013 and every year thereafter ("the Subsequent Works").
- 3. The Initial Works must be carried out:
 - (a) In accordance with Australian Standard 4373-2007 Pruning of Amenity Trees;
 - (b) By an appropriately insured arborist with a minimum of Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) level 3 in Arboriculture under the supervision of an arborist with an AQF level 5 in Arboriculture; and
 - (c) Within 90 days of the date of the final agreement.
- 4. The subsequent works must be carried out by an appropriately insured arborist with a minimum of AQF level 5 in Arboriculture.
- 5. The Tree-Keeper must give the applicant at least 48 hours notice prior to having the Initial Works and any future works carried out.



- 6. The applicant must provide necessary access to the arborist hired by the Tree-Keeper for the Initial Works and any future works to be carried out.
- 7. Each party pay their own cost of and incidental to the Application.
