Complainant's contentions on referral under the *Anti-Discrimination Act* 1991

General instructions

Contentions may be lodged

In person: Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal, Level 11, Bank of Queensland Building, 259 Queen Street, Brisbane QLD 4000, or at any Magistrates Court outside of the Brisbane CBD.

By mail: QCAT, GPO Box 1639, Brisbane 4001

PART A COMPLAINANT'S AND RESPONDENT'S DETAILS

- More than one complainant and respondent may be named in an application. If there is insufficient space for the names of either applicant or respondent you may attach additional pages with similar details.
- If the complainant or respondent is not an individual then the correct name must be used, for example:
 - · a company name
 - a business name regardless of whether it is registered under the Business Names Act 1962
 - a State agency name, for example Queensland Government department.
- Your address will be the address at which documents are given to you, unless you indicate your representative's address as your address for notices.
- Any change in your address for notices must be filed in the tribunal and given to all other parties.

Representative's details

If you want your representative's address as the address for notices, please complete your representative's details.

If you want your representative to represent you in any proceedings before the tribunal you must complete the form *Application for leave to be represented*. Generally the tribunal expects people to represent themselves. It may not grant your request.

You are not required to seek leave if:

- you are a child or a person with impaired capacity
- your case is a disciplinary case
- an Act or the Rules state that you may be legally represented.

PART B COMPLAINANT'S CONTENTIONS

You may wish to include the following:

- · a background of the relationship between the parties
- describe what happened OR confirm that you are relying on the facts set out in the complaint
- explain why you believe the respondent has discriminated against you with reference to the relevant sections of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1991* (see below)
- set out what has happened to you as a result of the discrimination, for example, psychological injury, loss of income, hurt and humiliation

It will be helpful for you to look at your complaint that you made to the Anti-Discrimination Commissioner when you are preparing your contentions, to ensure that your contentions are consistent with your complaint and no new allegations of discrimination are raised.

You must only refer to the facts alleged in the complaint to the Anti-Discrimination Commission Queensland. You cannot raise new allegations of discrimination in the contentions.

The reasons may include, but are not limited to, the following (all section references are to the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1991*):

- · whether you say the discrimination was direct or indirect pursuant to section 9
- if direct, explain why the discrimination is direct according to the meaning of "direct discrimination" in section 10
- if you say the discrimination is (or is also) indirect, explain why the discrimination is indirect according to the meaning of "indirect discrimination" in section 11
- if you are claiming that a person is liable for the acts of their workers or agents, explain why you believe this to be so, in terms of section 133
- if you are claiming that you were sexually harassed, explain why you believe you were sexually harassed within the meaning set out in section 119
- in the case of a complaint that includes a contention that you cannot obtain or are less able to
 obtain access to or use of any place or thing, why you do not have full access or use of that place
 or thing now and why any alteration you propose to the means of access or use will better provide
 access or use to you
- in the case of a complaint that includes a contention of vilification explain why you have been vilified in terms of section 124A(1)
- in the case of a complaint that includes a contention that you have been the subject of victimisation why you have been victimised in terms of section 130.

If you are seeking an order for the payment of money, include the basis on which the amount claimed has been calculated and the documents if any supporting the claim.

If you are seeking an order for costs include the reasons for which the order is sought having regard to the *Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 2009* and the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal Rules 2009.
