THE TRIBUNAL DIRECTS THAT:

1. Leah Margaret Wood is added as a Respondent.

IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. The Respondents, Adrian Hulme and Leah Margaret Wood, must trim the bamboo (identified as Bambusa textilis Gracilis) (the Bamboo) to no higher than 1.5 metres above the shared boundary fence and remove all the Bamboo 40 centimetres or less from the shared boundary fence to establish a clearance channel on or before 4:00pm on 30 April 2024.
- The Respondents, Adrian Hulme and Leah Margaret Wood, must undertake ongoing maintenance on the Bamboo every three months after the initial work outlined in Order 1 to:
 - (a) Trim the Bamboo back to no higher than 1.5 metres above the shared boundary fence; and
 - (b) Remove any Bamboo 40 centimetres or less from the shared boundary.
- 3. The ongoing maintenance of the Bamboo outlined in Order 2 will occur in January, April, July and October of each year.
- 4. The Respondents, **Adrian Hulme** and **Leah Margaret Wood**, will be responsible for all costs associated with undertaking the work outlined in Order 1 and Order 2.
