IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL, BY CONSENT, THAT:

- 1. The Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow** must engage a suitably qualified contractor to undertake the removal of the Camphor Laurel Tree (identified as Tree 1 in Mr James' Tree Assessment Report dated 27 September 2023) (Tree 1).
- 2. The Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow** must engage a suitably qualified contractor to grind down the exposed surface roots of Tree 1 and the exposed surface roots of the Kurranjong Tree (identified as Tree 2 in Mr James' Tree Assessment Report dated 27 September 2023) (Tree 2) on the Applicants', **Kathleen Moira McCormack's** and **Alan McCulloch's**, land.
- 3. The Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow**, must undertake severance and/or pruning of Tree 2 to provide clearance to the fence and fence post.
- 4. The Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow** must undertake the removal of the Arrowhead vine on the Silky Oak Tree (identified as Tree 3 in Mr James' Tree Assessment Report dated 27 September 2023) (Tree 3) to allow a suitably qualified arborist to conduct an inspection of Tree 3.
- 5. After the arborist's inspection of Tree 3 as outlined in Order 4, the Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Chervl Jayne Kussrow** must either:
 - (a) Remove Tree 3 by a suitably qualified contractor; or
 - (b) Engage an arborist to undertake an initial pruning of Tree 3 and formulate an ongoing maintenance and pruning schedule for Tree 3 (the Schedule).
- 6. The Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow** must undertake the work outlined in Order 1, Order 2, Order 3, Order 4 and Order 5 **on or before 4:00pm on 25 October 2024.**
- 7. The Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow**, must engage an arborist to undertake the ongoing maintenance and pruning of Tree 3 in accordance with the Schedule.
- 8. Any contractor engaged by the Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow** must be appropriately insured to undertake the work outlined in Order 1, Order 2 and/or Order 5(a).

- 9. The inspection outlined in Order 4 and the work outlined in Order 5(b) and Order 7 must be undertaken by an arborist with a minimum qualification of Australian Qualification Framework level 3 in arboriculture with appropriate insurances.
- 10. The Applicants, Kathleen Moira McCormack and Alan McCulloch must allow any contractor or arborist with appropriate insurances engaged by the Respondents, Neil John Kussrow and Cheryl Jayne Kussrow access to their land subject to seven (7) days' notice or notice as agreed between the parties.
- 11. The Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow** will be responsible for all costs associated with undertaking the work outlined in Order 1, Order 2, Order 3, Order 4, Order 5 and Order 7.
- 12. If the Respondents, Neil John Kussrow and Cheryl Jayne Kussrow, fail to undertake the work outlined in Order 1, Order 2, Order 3, Order 4, Order 5 or Order 7 the Applicants, Kathleen Moira McCormack and Alan McCulloch, shall be entitled to have the work undertaken by a suitably qualified contractor or arborist (as required) with appropriate insurances. The Applicants, Kathleen Moira McCormack and Alan McCulloch suitably qualified contractor or arborist with appropriate insurances shall be entitled to enter the Respondents', Neil John Kussrow's and Cheryl Jayne Kussrow's, land and carry out the outstanding work subject to the Applicants, Kathleen Moira McCormack and Alan McCulloch, giving 14 days written notice of that intention to the Respondents, Neil John Kussrow and Cheryl Jayne Kussrow.
- 13. The costs incurred by the Applicants, **Kathleen Moira McCormack** and **Alan McCulloch**, engaging a suitably qualified contractor or an arborist to undertake any of the outstanding work in default of the Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow**, shall be recoverable from the Respondents, **Neil John Kussrow** and **Cheryl Jayne Kussrow**, as a debt without further notice being required to be given.
