

## ORDER

## IT IS THE ORDER OF THE TRIBUNAL, BY CONSENT, THAT:

- The tree keepers at 55 Bridgman Drive, Reedy Creek, Queensland, 4227, (currently Francesco Marasco and Angelina Marasco), are to have the work described in this Order performed as follows:
  - a) initially, within ninety (90) days of this Order, and
  - b) thereafter, once every three years.
- 2. The work is to canopy clean, removing all dead, redundant, rubbing and crossing branches, from the crown of the *Corymbia Maculata* (Spotted Gum), (situated 3.2 metres from the common boundary with 53 Bridgman Drive, Reedy Creek, Queensland, 4227), with a visual and aerial inspection by a qualified Arborist.
- 3. The work is to be carried out:
  - a) in accordance with Australian Standard 4373-2007 'Pruning of Amenity Trees'; and
  - b) by a tree pruning contractor with a Minimum Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) Level 3 qualification in Arboriculture with appropriate insurance cover.
- 4. The work is to be carried out at the cost of the tree keepers (currently Francesco Marasco and Angelina Marasco).
- 5. No order is made as to costs.
