IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT:

- 1. The registered owners of 9 Gibson Grove, Emerald must, at their cost, arrange for the pruning of the *Calliandra haematocephala Hassk* (Powderpuff-tree) and all vines growing on the boundary fence between 7 and 9 Gibson Grove, Emerald:
 - a. On the first occasion, by 30 May 2024; and
 - b. Subsequently, annually by 30 May in each year,

to cut over-hanging tree branches back to within 50cm of the boundary fence and to entirely cut vines from touching or growing on the boundary fence.

- 2. The pruning of the aforesaid tree is to be completed by an appropriately qualified and insured arborist with a minimum qualification of an Australian Qualified Framework Level 3 Arborist. The pruning of vines may be undertaken by the registered owners of 9 Gibson Grove Emerald or by a gardener.
- 3. These orders do not prevent the aforesaid tree or vines being removed rather than pruned, at the election of the registered owners of 9 Gibson Grove, Emerald.
- 4. By 30 May 2024, Zane Geoffrey Johnson must pay Hayley Patricia Theodore the sum of \$669.39 being:
 - a. \$162.69 by way of compensation, and
 - b. \$506.70 for costs.
