
### THE TRIBUNAL DIRECTS THAT:

1. **Clayton Kevin Geaney** is added as an Applicant in these proceedings.
2. The Tribunal record is correct to reflect the Applicant's name on title is **Rebecca Jane Weston**.
3. **Renae Kim Englert** is added as a Respondent in these proceedings.

### IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL, BY CONSENT, THAT:

4. Each party must source two (2) quotes each for the removal of the bamboo the subject of the tree dispute (the Bamboo) and engage the contractor both parties agree on. In the absence of the parties agreeing, the contractor who provides the lowest quote will be engaged.
5. Each party is responsible to pay 50% of the engaged contractor's quote directly to the engaged contractor.
6. The contractor engaged to remove the Bamboo (the Work) must be suitably qualified and have the appropriate insurances.
7. Both parties must allow access to their respective lands for the engaged contractor with appropriate insurances to conduct the Work subject to three (3) days' notice.
8. The Work must be undertaken on or before **4:00pm on 2 August 2024**.
