## IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT:

- 1. On or before 24 May 2024 the Respondent is to cause to be carried out the works identified in paragraph 4.14 sub-paragraphs 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of the tree assessor's report dated 11 June 2023 at the Respondent's total cost:
  - a. Pruning to reduce the western spread of the Swamp Cypress (Taxodium Distichum) canopy to behind the boundary alignment of tree-keeper's property at 59 Christine Street, Caboolture, Queensland 4510.
  - b. The removal of all accessible deadwoods greater than 25mm in diameter and the internal thinning of the redundant internal canopy to a maximum of 20% canopy removal of the Swamp Cypress (Taxodium distichum) located within the tree-keeper's property at 59 Christine Street, Caboolture, Queensland 4510.
  - c. All tree debris to be removed from the applicant's / tree keeper's property after the recommended pruning is performed.
  - d. All pruning to be performed in compliance with the requirements of Australian Standard 4373-2007 "Pruning of amenity trees".
  - e. Climbing spurs/ climbing gaffs / climbing irons shall not be used during pruning works.
  - f. All works shall be performed by minimum Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) level three (3) qualified arborist.
  - g. The attending arborist / company shall provide proof of current Public Liability and Work Cover insurance prior to works onsite.
- 2. There is to be ongoing maintenance by the Respondent at intervals not exceeding two years to maintain the canopy of the Swamp Cypress (Taxodium distichum) located within the tree-keeper's property at 59 Christine Street Caboolture Queensland 4510 at its extent following the initial pruning in order 1 at the Respondent's cost.
