THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL IS THAT:

- 1. The Respondent tree-keeper is to cause to be carried out work on the bamboo clumps on the tree keepers property (Bambusa Ventricosa and Pseudosasa Japonica) within 6 weeks of the date of this order and then in each calendar year thereafter to:
 - i) Reduce the overall height of both clumps of bamboo to a maximum height of 3 metres: and
 - ii) Cut all bamboo back away from the dividing fence line to a minimum distance of 0.5 metres:
 - iii) The works in i and ii are to be conducted by a minimum AQF level 3 arborist with appropriate insurances;
 - iv) The works in i and ii must be performed in accordance with AS4373-2007 pruning of amenity trees and all work must be conducted according to industry codes of practice and Workplace Health and Safety Regulations.
- 2. The Respondent tree-keeper is to pay the costs associated with carrying out order 1 of this Order.
