IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT:

- 1. It is agreed between the parties that the four trees of subject to this dispute be removed and the area revegetated at the discretion of the respondent.
- 2. The removal of the 4 trees is to take place within 90 days of the date of this order.
- 3. The applicant agrees to contribute half of the cost of the works (including the revegetation works) up to a maximum of \$1000 (one thousand dollars).
- 4. The respondent is to deliver to the applicant a copy of all tax invoices associated with the works at which time the applicant will reimburse the respondent within 14 days of receipt and after the works have been completed.
- 5. All work is to be carried out according to Australian Standard 4373-2007 and be compliant with legislation (EPA, WHS QLD), local regulations and council laws.
- 6. Each party is to bear their own costs of and incidental to this application.
