IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

1. Six (6) palms situated on the Respondent's, **Mark Wilson's**, land will be removed by Barlows' Tree Services **on or before 29 March 2024**.
2. Barlow Tree Services must have appropriate insurances to undertake the work outlined in Order 1.
3. The Applicant, **Antje H Mittelstadt**, and the Respondent, **Mark Wilson**, must each give access to their land for Barlow Tree Services to undertake the removal of the six (6) palms subject to three days' notice or as agreed between the parties.
4. The Applicant, **Antje H Mittelstadt**, and the Respondent, **Mark Wilson**, will each contribute 50% towards the costs of removing the six (6) palms (total removal costs \$4,400.00).
