IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. On or before 4:00pm on 28 May 2025, David Alex Berwen Paine and Yeon Jeong Lee, must remove the entire tree in dispute situated on their land (identified as a Chinese Elm Tree in the Application for a tree dispute) (Tree 1) including the grinding and/or poisoning of Tree 1's stump to ensure Tree 1 is no longer alive (the Removal Work).
- 2. **David Alex Berwen Paine** and **Yeon Jeong Lee**, must engage a suitable contractor with appropriate insurances (including Public Liability Insurance) to undertake the Removal Work.
- 3. Dan Dobe and Kate Louise Dobe, must allow David Alex Berwen Paine's and Yeon Jeong Lee's elected suitable contractor access to their land to undertake the Removal Work subject to David Alex Berwen Paine and Yeon Jeong Lee givinig Dan Dobe and Kate Louise Dobe, three (3) days' notice.
- 4. **David Alex Berwen Paine** and **Yeon Jeong Lee**, will be responsible for all costs associated with the Removal Work.
- 5. If **David Alex Berwen Paine** and **Yeon Jeong Lee** fail to undertake the Removal Work, **Dan Dobe** and **Kate Louise Dobe** can engage a suitable contractor with appropriate insurances (including Public Liability Insurance) to enter **David Alex Berwen Paine** and **Yeon Jeong Lee's** land and undertake the Removal Work subject to **Dan Dobe** and **Kate Louise Dobe** giving **David Alex Berwen Paine** and **Yeon Jeong Lee** 14 days' written notice of that intention.
- 6. The costs incurred by **Dan Dobe** and **Kate Louise Dobe** engaging a suitable contractor to undertake the Removal Work in default of **David Alex Berwen Paine** and **Yeon Jeong Lee**, is recoverable from **David Alex Berwen Paine** and **Yeon Jeong Lee** as a debt without further notice being required to be given.
