IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT:

- 1. The registered owner of the lot at 87 Malbon Street, Eight Mile Plains 4113 ("the tree-keeper) must arrange for the total removal with either poisoning or grinding of stump to just below ground level ("the works") of the following trees located on the tree-keeper's land:
 - (a) The Schinus terebinthifolius (Broad-leaved Pepper) identified as Tree 13 in Attachment A; and
 - (b) The trees which are located in the narrow strip of land between the tree-keeper's fence and the Applicant's retaining wall in the area delineated in Attachment A.
- 2. The works must be carried out:
 - (a) By an appropriately insured arborist with a minimum of Australian Qualifications Framework level 3 in Arboriculture;
 - (b) Within 60 days of the date of this order.
- 3. The tree-keeper is responsible for:
 - (a) The cost of the works; and
 - (b) The costs of the attendance of Mr David Gunter, Tree Assessor, at the Tribunal Hearing on 6 June 2019.
