IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL, BY CONSENT, THAT:

- 1. The Respondents, **Suchita Balasubramanian** and **Niranjan Bhat Harnad** must engage a suitably qualified contractor to remove the tree, identified by the Applicant, **Kaori Napier** as a Golden Flame (the Work).
- 2. The Respondents, Suchita Balasubramanian and Niranjan Bhat Harnad must provide the Applicant, Kaori Napier with a quote by a suitably qualified contractor for the Work on or before 4:00pm on 22 May 2024.
- 3. Upon the Applicant, Kaori Napier, receiving the quote outlined in Order 2 and payment details for the Respondents, Suchita Balasubramanian and Niranjan Bhat Harnad, the Applicant, Kaori Napier must pay \$1,200.00 towards the cost of the Work outlined in Order 1 to the Respondents, Suchita Balasubramanian and Niranjan Bhat Harnad, on or before 4:00pm on 5 June 2024.
- 4. The suitably qualified contractor engaged by the Respondents, **Suchita Balasubramanian** and **Niranjan Bhat Harnad** must have appropriate insurance to undertake the Work.
- 5. The Applicant, **Kaori Napier** must allow the suitably qualified contractor engaged to undertake the Work access to her property upon the provision of three (3) days' notice or notice as agreed between the parties.
- 6. The Respondents, **Suchita Balasubramanian** and **Niranjan Bhat Harnad** must organise for the Work to be completed **on or before 4:00pm on 6 September 2024.**
