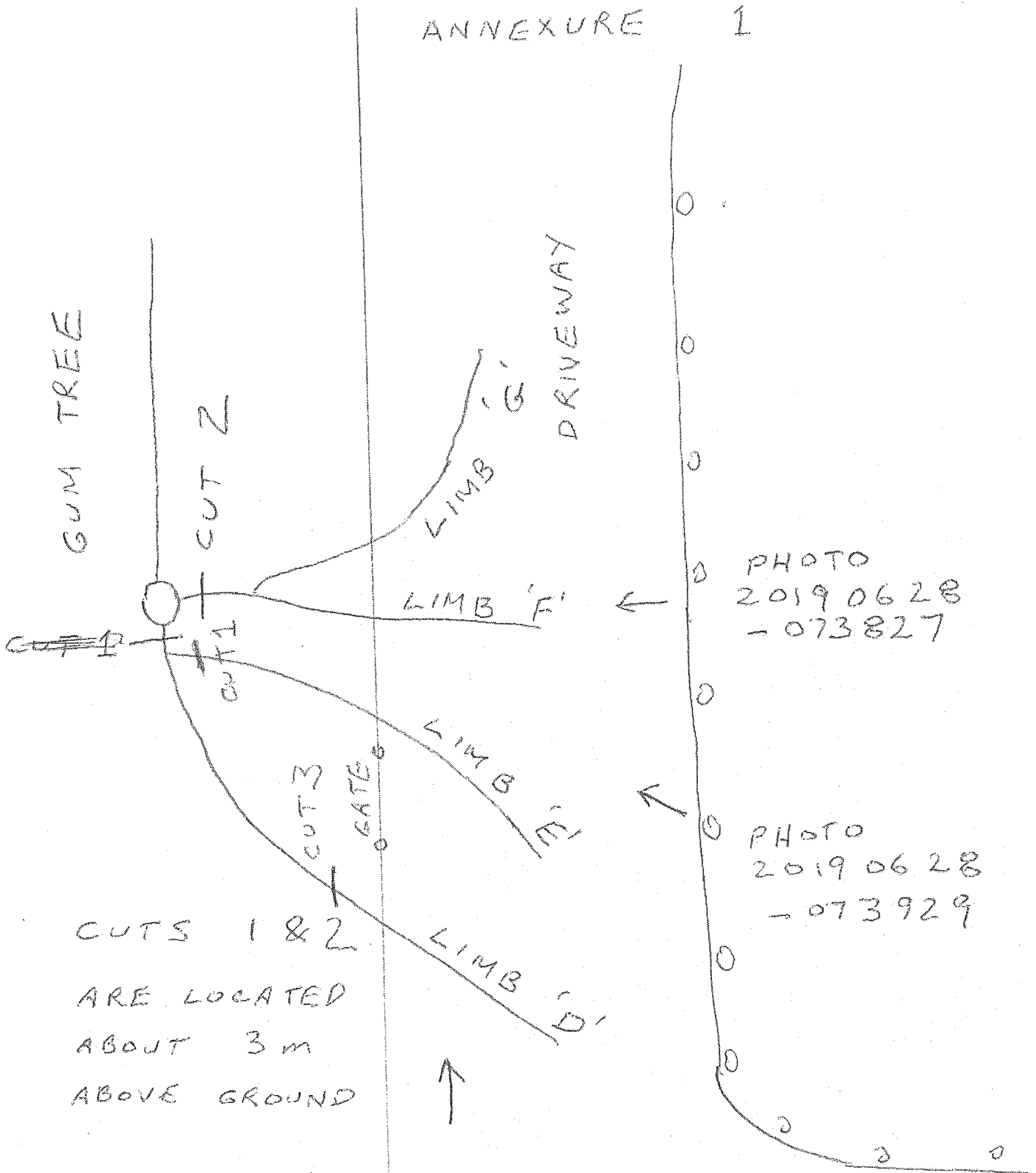
Initiating Document: Application for decision/order by consent filed 28 June 2019

IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

1. Each party will contribute half of the cost of appointing a qualified 'tree lopper' approved by the consulting arborist, David Hawthorne, to prune items (detailed below) to the Australian Standard AS4373-2007 by 31 August 2019:
 - (i) Three (3) designated branches of tree 3, *Corymbia torelliana* (Cadaghi) and remove any decayed branches or broken branches suspended in the canopy, as referenced in annexure 1.
 - (ii) One (1) designated branch of tree 6, *Xanthostemon chrysanthus* (Gold Penda), as referenced in annexure 2.
 - (iii) Three (3) designated branches of tree 8, *Ficus virens* (White Fig), remove any decayed branches and remove stubs from the previous pruning, as referenced in annexure 3.
