

Instructions regarding the appeal book

- 1. The appeal book must contain copies of documents used at the hearing that are directly relevant to the issues to be considered by the appeal tribunal.
- 2. The appeal book must have a cover sheet which identifies:
 - the appeal number
 - the parties
 - that it is an appeal book
 - if the appeal book is more than 1 volume, the volume number and page range of the book.
- 3. The second page of the appeal book must be an index. The index must:
 - describe the document
 - note the date of the document
 - state who filed the document
 - give it a page number.
- 4. It is not necessary to include the same document multiple times (e.g. an attachment to a number of other documents) if the documents are identical. Include one document and then include a reference to the relevant page number for that document.
- 5. If a document has attachments, each attachment must be separately identified and indexed.
- 6. Every page must be numbered.
