## IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- On or before 4:00pm on 16 August 2024, the Respondents, Brian Fletcher and Jodene Fletcher, must prune the Leopardwood Tree (identified as Tree 1 in Mr Richards' Tree Assessment Report dated 29 December 2023) to:
  - (a) undertake a complete canopy clean including removal of dead or dying limbs, removal of crossing and rubbing branches and internal canopy thinning; and
  - (b) undertake raising for clearance and subduction pruning in the upper canopy to supress elongation on the western extent (a canopy lift and reduction to the canopy extending onto the Applicant's, **Emily Madden's**, land.)<sup>1</sup>
- 2. The Respondents, **Brian Fletcher** and **Jodene Fletcher**, must engage an arborist, with a minimum qualification of Australian Qualification Framework level 3 and appropriate insurances, to undertake the work outlined in Order 1 and to formulate on ongoing maintenance and pruning schedule for Tree 1 (the Schedule).
- 3. The Respondents, **Brian Fletcher** and **Jodene Fletcher**, must engage a contractor with appropriate insurances to undertake the Schedule for Tree 1.
- 4. The work outlined in Order 1, Order 2 and Order 3 will be at the cost of the Respondents, **Brian Fletcher** and **Jodene Fletcher**.
- 5. The Applicant, **Emily Madden**, must allow the Respondents', **Brian Fletcher's** and **Jodene Fletcher's**, elected arborist or elected contractor with appropriate insurances, access to her land to undertake the work outlined in Order 1, Order 2 and Order 3 subject to three (3) days' notice or as agreed between the parties.
