IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT, BY CONSENT:

- Bridget Nichole WIlliams the registered owner of the lot at 201 Russell Street Cleveland, will arrange to have these works carried out on the trees the subject of the dispute:
 - (a) Remove the fig tree by:

31 January 2020.

(b) Trim and maintain the branches of the leopard tree back to the boundary fence line so that they do not overhang onto the property at 21 Highview drive Cleveland by:

31 March 2019.

- 2. All works are to comply with the requirement of Australian Standard 4373-2007 *Pruning of amenity trees*.
- 3. All works are to be completed by an appropriately qualified and insured arborist with a minimum qualification of Australian Qualifications Framework level 3.
- 4. All works are to be at the cost of Bridget Nichole Williams, except that Todd Christian Hansen will contribute one half of the costs of the works in paragraph 1 (a) and (b).
- 5. All works are to be carried out within 90 days of the date of this order.
- 6. The application is otherwise dismissed.
