IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL, THAT:

1. The Respondent, **Shannon Smith** must provide the Applicants, **William Thomas Charles**McNaught and Alison Hepworth three (3) quotes by a suitably qualified contractor to remove the Gum Tree in dispute (the Work) on or before 4:00pm on 31 May 2024.

- 2. Upon presentation of the quotes outlined in Order 1, the Applicants, **William Thomas**Charles McNaught and Alison Hepworth must pay half of the cost (50%) towards the cost of the cheapest quote directly to the suitably qualified contractor on or before 4:00pm on 7

 June 2024.
- 3. Upon payment of the Applicants, **William Thomas Charles McNaught's** and **Alison Hepworth's** to the suitably qualified contractor, the Respondent, **Shannon Smith** must engage that suitably qualified contractor to undertake the Work outlined in Order 1.
- 4. The suitably qualified contractor engaged by the Respondent, **Shannon Smith** must have appropriate insurance to undertake the Work.
- 5. The Applicants, **William Thomas Charles McNaught** and **Alison Hepworth** must allow the suitably qualified contractor engaged to undertake the Work access to their property upon the provision of three (3) days' notice or notice as agreed between the parties.
- 6. The Respondent, **Shannon Smith** must organise for the Work to be completed **on or before 4:00pm on 9 August 2024.**
- 7. The Applicants, **William Thomas Charles McNaught** and **Alison Hepworth** must not object to the application by the Respondent, **Shannon Smith** to seek a fire permit for the burning of residual vegetation following the removal of the tree.
