## IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. On or before 4:00pm on 27 December 2024, the Respondents, Colin Renz, Patricia Renz, Haley Renz and Christopher Renz must undertake an initial pruning on the Lychee Tree (Tree 1) to reduce its height to no more than three (3) metres and remove/prune back any branches overhanging the parties' shared boundary fence.
- 2. If required, the Respondents, Colin Renz, Patricia Renz, Haley Renz and Christopher Renz must undertake maintenance of Tree 1 in May of each year to reduce its height to no more than three (3) metres and remove/prune back any branches overhanging the parties' shared boundary fence.
- 3. The Respondent, Colin Renz, Patricia Renz, Haley Renz and Christopher Renz, will be responsible for all costs associated with the work on Tree 1 outlined in Order 1 and Order 2.
- 4. If the Respondents, Colin Renz, Patricia Renz, Haley Renz and Christopher Renz, fail to undertake the work outlined in Order 1 and/or Order 2, the Applicants, Keith Gordon Taylor and Julenne Taylor, shall be entitled to have the work undertaken by an arborist with a minimum qualification of Australian Qualification Framework level 3 in arboriculture with appropriate insurances. The Applicants,' Keith Gordon Taylor's and Julenne Taylor's, arborist shall be entitled to enter the Respondents,' Colin Renz's, Patricia Renz's, Haley Renz's and Christopher Renz's, land and carry out the incomplete work subject to the Applicants, , Keith Gordon Taylor's and Julenne Taylor's, giving 14 days written notice of that intention to the Respondents, Colin Renz, Patricia Renz, Haley Renz and Christopher Renz.
- 5. The costs incurred by the Applicants, **Keith Gordon Taylor's** and **Julenne Taylor's**, engaging an arborist to undertake the work in default of the Respondents, **Colin Renz**, **Patricia Renz**, **Haley Renz** and **Christopher Renz**, shall be recoverable from the Respondents, **Colin Renz**, **Patricia Renz**, **Haley Renz** and **Christopher Renz**, as a debt without further notice being required to be given.

6. If the Respondents, Colin Renz, Patricia Renz, Haley Renz and Christopher Renz, undertake the incomplete work during the 14 days' notice period outlined in Order 4, the Applicants', Keith Gordon Taylor's and Julenne Taylor's, right to engage an arborist to undertake the incomplete work is extinguished.
