

IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT, BY CONSENT

1. An appropriately qualified and insured arborist with a minimum qualification of Australian Qualifications Framework level 3 will prune three (3) trees identified as Tree 10, Tree 11 and Tree 12 in the Tree Assessment Report dated 28 January 2019. The pruning involves;
 - (a) trimming back overhanging branches of Tree 10, Tree 11 and Tree 12, to the boundary fence, and
 - (b) Prune three (3) metres from the height of Tree 10 identified as a Cheese Tree.
2. The applicant and the respondent will each seek quotations for this work and provide the quotes to each other on or before **18 June 2019**.
3. The applicant and the respondent will decide on the quote and engage the arborist on or before **22 July 2019**.
4. The party engaging the arborist will give the other party seven (7) days written notice that the work will commence for the pruning of the trees. The applicant and the respondent will allow the arborist reasonable access to their properties to perform the work.
5. All of the pruning work will be undertaken on or before **30 September 2019**.
6. The applicant and the respondent will each pay half of the cost of the work.
7. The application is otherwise dismissed.
