

## **QCAT Practice Direction No. 3 of 2024**

## Format of documents created by a party for filing in the tribunal

- 1. This practice direction applies to all Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal (QCAT) proceedings.
- 2. The purpose of this practice direction is to prescribe the formatting requirements for documents submitted to QCAT.
- 3. Where documents are submitted in typed format, they must be:
  - a. Printed double-sided on A4 size paper;
  - b. No smaller than 12 point in Times New Roman font, or 11 point in Arial font; and
  - c. No less than 1.5 line spacing.
- 4. A statement of evidence together with its attached documents submitted to QCAT must be sequentially page numbered with each page showing a unique page number.
- 5. Where documents are submitted in handwritten format, the documentation must be legible in clear, hand-printed letters in ink.
- 6. Where a party does not comply with this practice direction, they may be directed by the Tribunal to re-submit the material in compliance with the prescribed requirements.
