IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. On or before 4:00pm on 1 November 2025, Van Bich Du and Toan Phuoc Luc must remove all the *Bambusa sp* (discussed in Michael Sowden's Tree Assessment Report dated 20 October 2024) (the Bamboo) and to ensure the Bamboo does not regrow:
 - a) grind out the Bamboo's roots and rhizomes; and/or
 - b) poison the Bamboo.
- 2. **Van Bich Du** and **Toan Phuoc Luc** must engage a competent contractor with appropriate insurances (including Public Liability Insurance) (the Elected Contractor) to undertake the removal work outlined in Order 1.
- 3. If required, **Jay Thomas** and **Rachel Lee Thomas** must give the Elected Contractor access to their land to undertake the work outlined in Order 1 subject to **Van Bich Du** and **Toan Phuoc Luc** giving seven (7) days' notices.
- 4. **Van Bich Du** and **Toan Phuoc Luc** will be responsible for all costs associated with the removal work outlined in Order 1.
- 5. If Van Bich Du and Toan Phuoc Luc, fails to undertake any of the removal work outlined in Order 1 (the Outstanding Work), Jay Thomas and Rachel Lee Thomas can engage their own competent contractor with appropriate insurances (including Public Liability Insurance) to enter Van Bich Du and Toan Phuoc Luc's land and carry out the Outstanding Work subject to Jay Thomas and Rachel Lee Thomas giving 14 days written notice of that intention to Van Bich Du and Toan Phuoc Luc.
- 6. The costs incurred by Jay Thomas and Rachel Lee Thomas engaging their own competent contractor with appropriate insurances (including Public Liability Insurance) to undertake the Outstanding Work in default of Van Bich Du and Toan Phuoc Luc is recoverable from Van Bich Du and Toan Phuoc Luc as a debt without further notice being required to be given.
