## IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. In the months of **February** and **August** of each year, the Respondent, **Jane Brennan**, must undertake the maintenance work outlined in Order 2 and Order 3 (the Maintenance Work) on:
  - (a) the Lemon Scented Myrtle (identified as Tree Number 2 in Mr Richards' Tee Assessment Report dated 4 September 2023) (Tree 2); and
  - (b) the mature Leopardwood Trees (identified as Tree Number 3, Tree Number 4, Tree Number 5, Tree Number 6 and Tree Number 7 in Mr Richards' Tree Assessment Report dated 4 September 2023) (Tree 3, tree 4, Tree 5, Tree 6 and Tree 7); and
  - (c) the mature Silky Oak (identified as Tree Number 8 in Mr Richards' Tree Assessment Report dated 4 September 2023) (Tree 8); and
  - (d) the collection of various foundation plants including Sheena's Gold, Ornamental Clumping Bamboo, Golden Can Palms and Powder Puff Plants (identified as Tree Number 9 in Mr Richards' Assessment Report dated 4 September 2023) (Tree 9).
- 2. The Respondent, Jane Brennan, must prune Tree 2, Tree 3, Tree 4, Tree 5, Tree 6, Tree 7, Tree 8 and Tree 9 (the Trees') lateral limbs extending towards the Applicants', Peter Mastroianni's and Tracey Ann Mastroianni's, land to maintain the Trees' footprint within the Respondent's, Jane Brennan's, land.
- The Respondent, Jane Brennan, must prune the Trees' height to below the gutter height of the Respondent's, Jane Brennan's, dwelling.
- 4. The Respondent, Jane Brennan, must undertake the initial Maintenance Work in the month of August 2024.
- 5. The Respondent, **Jane Brennan**, will be responsible for all costs associated with the Maintenance Work.
