THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

1. The respondent must carry out the following tree works:

- a. Prune the clumping bamboo twice yearly to prevent culms encroaching beyond the dividing fence and to maintain an upright façade;
- b. Prune all bamboo culms to ground level, when pruned, to eliminate lower foliage protruding through the dividing fence;
- c. Provide a 200mm division between the bamboo culms and the dividing fence;
- d. Maintain the height of the clumping bamboo to a maximum height of 4 4.5 metres above ground level.
- 2. The respondent is to pay for the tree work referred to in paragraph 1 above.
- 3. The initial works referred to in 1 must be carried out by 28 February 2025.
