

## **QCAT Practice Direction No 3 of 2009**

## **Consent orders**

- 1. If parties to a proceeding agree about the terms of an order they want the tribunal to make, the principal registrar may make the orders without a hearing if the parties provide the principal registrar with their written consent.
- 2. The principal registrar may decline to make an order in that way:
  - (a) about matters which require the tribunal to exercise its discretion; or
  - (b) if, for any other reason, the principal registrar considers the matter should be referred to the tribunal.
