THE TRIBUNAL DIRECTS BY CONSENT THAT:

 The respondent tree-keeper/s shall prune the trees listed in the schedule attached hereto (the trees) on their land at 5 Cleland Crescent, Broadbeach Waters to the heights set out in the schedule in respect of each tree (the work).

- 2. The work is to be undertaken by a suitably qualified tree lopper with appropriate insurance cover under the supervision of a suitably qualified arborist at the cost of the tree-keeper/s.
- 3. The work shall be completed within 6 weeks from the date hereof.
- 4. Should that work not be completed within that time the applicant/s shall be entitled to have the work performed by a suitably qualified tree lopper with appropriate insurance cover under the supervision of a suitably qualified arborist.
- 5. Should the applicant/s be required to carry out the work (and/or the annual pruning stipulated for below) in default of it being done by the tree-keeper/s a suitably qualified tree lopper with appropriate insurance cover under the supervision of a suitably qualified arborist engaged by the applicant/s (or successors in title) shall be entitled to enter the tree-keeper's land to carry out the work subject to the applicant/s giving 14 days written notice of that intention to the tree-keeper/s at the tree-keeper/s last known address.

6. The costs incurred by the applicant/s engaging a tree lopper and arborist to do the work in

default of the tree-keeper/s shall be recoverable from the tree-keeper/s as a debt without

further notice being required to be given.

7. The tree-keeper/s shall ensure a suitably qualified tree lopper tree lopper with appropriate

insurance cover under the supervision of a suitably qualified arborist attends and prunes the

trees to the heights set out in the schedule attached every 12 months after the trees are first

pruned in accordance with Order 1 above.

8. The tree-keeper/s and any tree lopper or arborist engaged by the tree-keeper/s to perform the

work or annual pruning shall be entitled to enter the applicants' land at 3 Cleland Crescent,

Broadbeach Waters subject to 24 hours written notice being given of the work to be done.

9. A suitably qualified arborist shall be someone with a minimum qualification of Australian

Qualifications Framework (AQF) level 5 in arboriculture.

10. These orders shall remain in force and effect for a period of 10 years from the date hereof.

6.	Start Fruit Tree (Averrhoa carambola)	4 metres
