



**PRESIDENTIAL DIRECTION NO 4 OF 2004
ACCOUNTS OF ADMINISTRATION TO THE DATE OF DEATH**

Pursuant to s49 of the *Guardianship and Administration Act 2000*, administrators are required to keep records. In addition, Presidential Direction 1 of 2003 requires administrators to lodge accounts of administration on an annual basis.

Date of Death

Orders of the Tribunal cease upon the death of the adult and the law relating to the administration of a deceased person's estate applies. Administrators are however, responsible for the estate to the date of death and are required to:

- (a) complete and keep a form of accounts for the period to the date of death; and
- (b) provide the original accounts of administration to the date of death to the executor or person authorised to administer the estate of the adult.

Accounts of administration are **not** required to be lodged with the Tribunal.
