IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. On or before 4:00pm on 6 September 2024, the Respondent, Clinton Powell will grind down and <u>for poison the three (3) Chinese Elm stumps (the Trees) situated on his land to ensure the Trees are dead.</u>
- 2. The Respondent, **Clinton Powell**, must engage a contractor with appropriate insurances (including Public Liability Insurance) to undertake the work outlined in Order 1.
- 3. The Respondent, **Clinton Powell**, will be responsible for all costs associated with work outlined in Order 1.
- 4. The Respondent, Clinton Powell, must grind down the Trees' stumps situated on his land on or before 4:00pm on 30 May 2025.
