

QCAT Practice Direction No 10 of 2010

Private audio-recording of proceedings: Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal

- 1. The audio-tape of tribunal proceedings issued by the State Reporting Bureau is and will remain the authoritative record of proceedings.
- 2. Representatives of news agencies covering the tribunal will be permitted to make a private audio recording, provided it is done unobtrusively and without interruption of the proceedings. For that purpose, a hand-held recorder may be taken into a hearing room and activated.
- 3. The purpose of permitting such recording is to maintain accuracy in the reporting of tribunal proceedings. The audio content of the recording may not be broadcast.
- 4. This practice direction does not impinge on the tribunal's right to revise, subsequently, a judgement delivered ex tempore; or the tribunal's right, in a particular case, to prohibit recording, should the tribunal consider that necessary or desirable.
