IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT:

- 1. Lai Ho, the registered owner of the lot at 16 Curlew Crescent, Eagleby ("the Tree-Keeper") will arrange for the removal of:
 - a. The Syagrus Romanzoffiana (trees 1 and 2 also known as Cocos Palm); and
 - b. The Corymbia Tesselaris (tree 3 also known as Moreton Bay Ash)

the subject of this dispute ("the Works) and pay for their removal at his own cost.

- 2. The removal of the *Syagrus Romanzoffiana* (trees 1 and 2 also known as Cocos Palm) and the *Corymbia Tesselaris* (tree 3 also known as Moreton Bay Ash) is to be completed by an appropriately qualified and insured Arborist with a minimum qualification of an Australian Qualifications Framework Level 3.
- 3. Lai Ho will give Barry McDonald not less than 14 days notice in writing of the aborist's intention to attend and remove the *Syagrus Romanzoffiana* (trees 1 and 2 also known as Cocos Palm) and the *Corymbia Tesselaris* (tree 3 also known as Moreton Bay Ash).
- 4. The removal of the *Syagrus Romanzoffiana* (trees 1 and 2 also known as Cocos Palm) and the *Corymbia Tesselaris* (tree 3 also known as Moreton Bay Ash) is to be carried out within 90 days of the date of this order.
- 5. Each party will bear their own costs to this proceeding.
