IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL BY CONSENT THAT:

- On or before 4:00pm 7 February 2025, Anne Sok Lean Ting must remove all the Chinese Elms situated on Anne Sok Lean Ting's land along the parties shared common boundary. The removal work includes undertaking stump grinding or stump poisoning to ensure the Chinese Elms do not resprout.
- 2. On or before 4:00pm 7 February 2025, Anne Sok Lean Ting must remove the Jacaranda Tree situated on Anne Sok Lean Ting's land and encroaching onto John O'Donnell's land. The removal work includes undertaking stump grinding or stump poisoning to ensure the Jacaranda Tree does not resprout.
- 3. **Anne Sok Lean Ting** must engage a contractor with appropriate insurances (including Public Liability Insurance) to undertake the removal work outlined in Order 1 and Order 2.
- 4. **Anne Sok Lean Ting** will be responsible for all costs associated with the removal work outlined in Order 1 and Order 2.
- 5. If required, John O'Donnell must allow Anne Sok Lean Ting's elected contractor with appropriate insurances (including Public Liability Insurance) access to his land to undertake the removal work outlined in Order 1 and/or Order 2 subject to Anne Sok Lean Ting giving John O'Donnell three (3) days' notice.
